

June 1, 2021, Bear Creek Quilt Guild Board Zoom Meeting Minutes

President, Kathi Runyan opened the meeting at 6:30 pm on ZOOM with the following officers and members present: Kathi Runyan, Nancy Carr, Kay Thomas, Kyle Mills, Kathy Longo, JoAnne Sheppard, Aleta Mayrose, Pam Roark, Mary Nalley, Vicky Kidd, Beverly Douglas, Betty Reisch, Michelle Lewis, Susan Turk, and Debra Heid. Kathi welcomed everyone to the meeting. May Board minutes were reviewed and motion to accept was made by Kay Thomas, with a second by Nancy Carr, and the motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: Kyle Mills reported income of \$35.14 (new member fee), expenses of \$169.86 with a net loss of \$134.72.

2nd **VP:** Aleta reported the June Guild meeting will have no speakers, as it will be the 30th Anniversary celebration of the Bear Creek Quilt Guild. Presently, Aleta and Kathi Runyan are exploring other options for meeting places if the church isn't open to outside groups. There are no prospects as of yet.

No other officer reports.

Unfinished Business:

1) Scholarship Update—Nancy Carr reported it has been a challenging year with no applications for the BCQG scholarship. Therefore, the committee has decided to table it until next year and will continue to promote it for then.

New Business:

- 1) August Meeting on Facebook LIVE—Kathi Runyan announced the August 17, 2021, meeting presentation will be delivered on the FB Live platform by Martelli tables. They will demonstrate their products via the Guild's Facebook page since they will not be in attendance for the Guild's Quilt Show. This provides a better platform to reach more individuals for their presentation. The presentation will begin at 7:30pm, after the guild ZOOM meeting at 7pm. Members will receive access to a discount code to use on Martelli's website. More information to follow as we near the August meeting.
- **2)** June Guild meeting—June 15th Guild meeting to be held at Bear Creek Park, weather permitting. Kathi Runyan will purchase cupcakes, regular and gluten-free, and water as refreshments. Picnic tables will be available, and individuals may bring their own chair if desired. Kathi also encouraged everyone to bring Show and Tell items to share. Email blast with specifics to go out to all members.
- **3) Quilt Show update**—Kay Thomas reminded us that today, June 1, 2021, is the deadline for quilts to be registered as entered into the August Quilt Show. Updated numbers were sent to guilds this weekend to encourage more registrations. Kay reported that as of 5pm today, they have 311 quilts; the goal is 300-350 quilts. For the mini quilts, 34 have been registered so far, the deadline is June 15th. The goal is 180 mini quilts. There is also a need for volunteers. Please reach out if interested in volunteering. Paper tickets are being requested to be sold, more to follow. Quilt Show T-shirts are being sold at \$15.00 each. Information may be found in the newsletter and via a guild email blast.

June 15, 2021, Bear Creek Quilt Guild Member In Person Meeting Minutes

President, Kathi Runyan, opened the meeting and welcomed everyone at 7:15pm at Bear Creek Park pavilion. Attendance was taken by Michelle Lewis. The May 2021 Guild member meeting minutes were reviewed and a motion to accept was made by Nancy Carr, seconded by Colleen Connor, and motion was approved. Kathi announced her congratulations on the Bear Creek Quilt Guild's 30th Anniversary, and cupcakes were served! Kathi also recognized Cathy Braunreiter, who is a charter member in the guild.

Treasurer's Report: Kyle Mills reported income of \$35.00, expenses of \$205.00, with a net balance of -\$169.00.

2nd VP Report: Aleta Mayrose reported that the speaker for the July meeting will be Annette Plog, lecturing on her 1800 Blue Fabric quilts. In August, there are plans for a Martelli table demonstration via Facebook live-- more information to follow. In September, the speaker will be Winnie Fleming presenting her lecture on Star quilts, with possibly a workshop.

New Business:

- 1) Quilt Show Update: Kay Thomas reported that 325 quilts and 99 mini quilts have been entered into the quilt show. Mini quilts can still be dropped off to JoAnne or Mona by June 22, 2021. Quilt show tickets are available tonight for \$10.00 and \$15.00 at the door. Brochures will be available for businesses. T-shirts are available for purchase. Quilt Show quilts drop off is Sunday, August 15, 2021, from 1pm-5pm, with no parking fee. Quilt Show parking will be \$10.00/day, during the Quilt Show.
- **2) Membership:** Michelle Lewis reported that 33 members are in attendance tonight. There is one new member present, Marilyn Kowalski, and she was introduced to the guild.
- **3) Post Board meeting item for discussion:** An item for discussion after the regular Board meeting came up, and it was handled via email to Board members. The item was regarding the sponsoring of Quilt Show ribbons by making a one-time \$300.00 donation from BCQG to sponsor a First Place ribbon winner with a cash award. In the past, only a few awards included cash awards. A few other guilds have donated and Bear Creek was asked to consider making a donation as well. After much discussion and clarification, the membership voted on making the one-time NTQF Ribbon sponsorship donation of \$300.00 for winner awards. Membership voted yes unanimously to make the donation.
- **4) Retreat Update:** There is a retreat scheduled for September 23-27, 2021, at Red Boot Retreat in Hillsborough, Texas. You can register with Susan Turk. Susan reported she has 23 paid attendees so far. Maximum is 24 or 25, then she will begin a waiting list of attendees in case of cancellations.
- **5)** August Member meeting: Kathi Runyan reported that the August 17th member meeting will be held online with a demonstration by Martelli Enterprises. More information to follow.

Committee Reports:

- **--Community Service:** Deb Heid reported that donations were dropped off at JPS approximately 2 weeks ago. They were very grateful for the donations of receiving blankets, etc. and are now asking for adult size lap quilts. Deb doesn't have a specific size requested yet but will look into and post sizes on our website. Deb also reminded everyone to get their volunteer hours documented and submitted to her as soon as possible each month.
- **--Quilts of Valor:** Beverly announced that four Quilts of Valor are ready for presentation. The plan is to present the four quilts in November 2021, near to Veteran's Day. Beverly is also requesting a donation of 2.5-3 yards of 108 in. backing fabric as well as 120 inches of 80/20 batting, or if someone knows where the committee can get this wholesale. Supplies are getting depleted.
- **--Quilt Show Boutique:** Kayleen Allen thanked everyone for their boutique items so far . She reminded everyone that on Monday, June 20, at 10 am, there will be a meeting at her house to collate and finish up items for the boutique.

Show and Tell items were presented, along with enjoying refreshments.

The next BCQG member meeting is scheduled for July 20, 2021, on ZOOM at 7pm. The next BCQG Board meeting is scheduled for July 6, 2021, 6:30pm, if needed.

Meet adjourned at 8:10pm.
